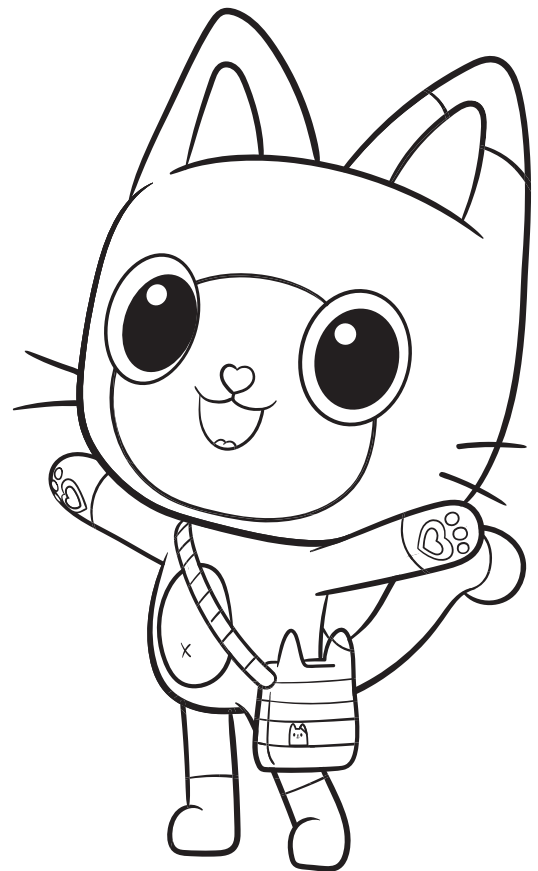
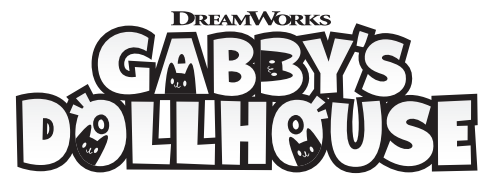
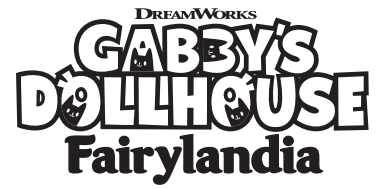








CAT-TASTIC CAT EARS!

Just like Gabby at the dollhouse, it's time to get tiny! Make your own cat ears and play pretend with your kitty cat friends.



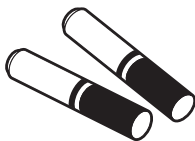
What you'll need



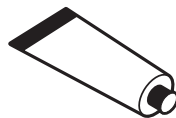
Headband

Black Paint (Optional)



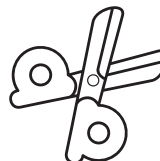
Pink Sparkles



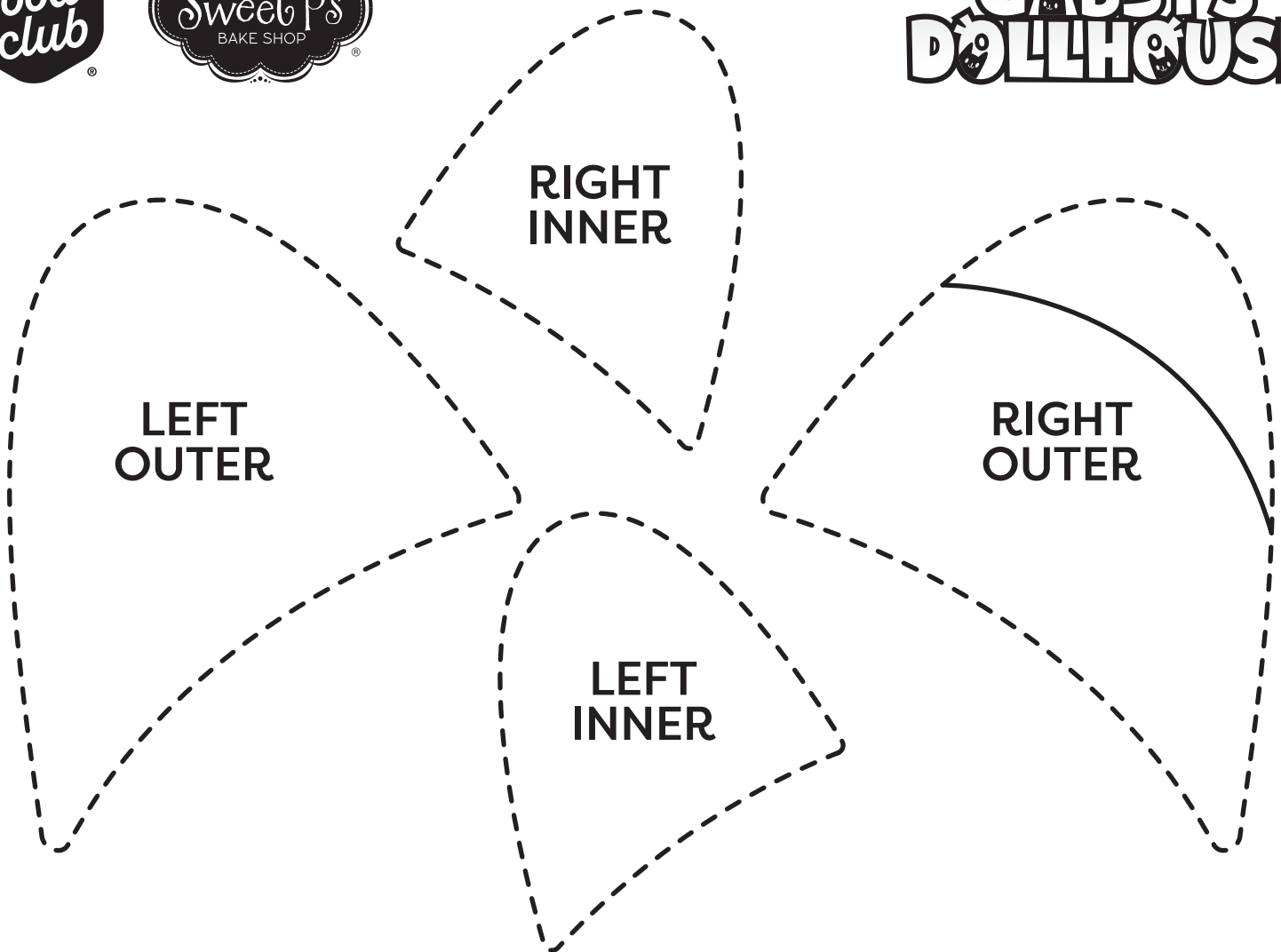
White Glue

Instructions

1. First things first, you'll need a headband. If you have one at home you don't wear anymore, that works perfectly. It's time to get crafty-riffic!
2. Now it's time to start making your cat ears. Print this activity, and with the help of a grown-up, cut out the cat ear stencils.
3. Place the stencils on your cardboard, and trace around them with a black marker. Have a grown-up help you cut them out.
4. Here's where it gets fun! Paint the outer ears white, and once they're dry, use a black marker or black paint to make your ears look just like Pandy Paws!
5. Just like Baby Box says, "glitter makes everything better!" Cover one side of your inner ear cardboard pieces with glue, and sprinkle on your pink sparkles. Make sure to use a piece of paper to catch the rest of the sparkles!
6. Once everything is dry, glue the inner ear pieces onto the outer ears. Then, have a grown up help you hot glue each ear onto your headband.
7. Just like Gabby, it's time to get tiny and have fun at the dollhouse!
